Ripe pears and fruits mingle on the middle of the tasting, while the back of the tongue gets a brown sugar, maple syrup, and black pepper sensation. The Wood Experimental Collection was inspired by an enlightening trip to a wine cooerage in Missouri. Wine barrels are almost exclusively toasted oak, as opposed to bourbon's charred, brand-new barrels, which yield a high-oak flavor profile. This is what inspired Trey Zoeller to embark on an experimental journey with a 4-year-old bourbon, aging it in new charred white oak barrels, and finishing it in 13 different environments/vessels. "Over a period of 32 months, we charted the characteristics of each experiment monthly and analyzed how the different treatments have affected the outcome of the final whiskey"
#3 - finished in new 60-gallon American oak barrels with a low, deep impact toast profile.
#4 - finished in a new standard whiskey barrel with medium char, infused with heavily charred American oak cubes.
#10 - finished in a hybrid 60 gallon French and American barrel with a low, deep impact toast profile.
